

# ALOA Associate Membership

## Policies & Procedures for Associate Members

### Membership Category

As of May 2012 the Australian Landfill Owners Association (ALOA) has set up a new membership category – Associate Member.

### Qualification Criteria

Associate Membership allows landfill owners that landfill less than 15,000 tonnes of waste per annum to join ALOA.

### Constitution

The new membership category has been set in accordance with Article 6.2 in the ALOA constitution:

#### **Article 6.2 Classes of Members**

ALOA consists of the following classes of Members:

- a) Founding Members; and
- b) General Members.

The Board has the right and power from time to time to create new categories of membership with such rights, privileges and obligations as are determined applicable (other than voting rights), even if the effect of creating a new category is to alter rights, privileges or obligations of an existing category of Members. No new category of membership may be granted voting rights.

### Membership Rights

Associate Members receive all privileges that General Members and Founding Members receive but they are **not** allowed to vote at either Federal or State Chapter Level.

### Membership Benefits

The benefits of Associate Membership:

- Receive all updates from both Federal & State Chapter Level.
- Able to join & participate in local State Chapter.
- Lobby on behalf of landfill owners on important industry issues.
- Access to information and knowledge of various industry leaders.

### Membership Fee & Renewal

Membership of ALOA is for a period of 12 months. Each renewal of membership is for a further period of 12 months.

### Terms & Conditions of Membership

Associate members must to adhere to ALOA Terms & Conditions of Service to Members, which can be found on the ALOA website.
